

Member benefits vs. rental leagues and public demands

Adopted – EC meeting – March 13, 2018

MEMBER

- Possibility of twenty-six (26) weeks of games. May vary based on scheduled tournaments;
- Curling Québec's member affiliation fees;
- Free ice access for practice (reservation required based on the Center's schedule);
- Multiple league choices with a priority of these choices over rental leagues;
- Access to a locker (limited number). Cost: \$25 for the season;
- Voting rights at general meetings;
- Possibility of playing as a spare in all other internal leagues, in unlimited number of games at no additional cost, where the list of payor spares is not sufficient. Condition: on a trial basis for the first year of operation. To be revised later;
- Access to a free training session each year, curling initiation, two hours at the start of the season;
- League's social activities. For example: Christmas and end of season's party (free use of observation room and ice). Reservation required;
- Activities open to the public. For example: curling & pizza night. Free use of ice for the member player. Other expenses must be paid, such as food;
- Personal activities (preferential rates to rent the Center – ice and/or observation room);
- Curling 101 – adult training program for beginners – includes the membership if the player registers for the season.

Rental/association leagues

- Time and day to be determined in advance – negotiated based on availability following the members's choices;
- Fixed number of games per season – maximum of 24 weeks;
